Scenario

Context

- Organizations often work together but they are separate tenants. Users cannot search another organization's list of contacts.
- Communication via federation requires the end user already knows the contact's email or phone number but getting those details can be difficulty if not already known.

Current State



Users between organizations cannot communicate unless they have been explicitly provided the contact details of another person.

Users revert to previous ways of working if they are not given the right information are the right time, such as using a desk phone for calling if they do not have easy access to a contact's phone number to start a Teams call.

▲ Employees lose time trying to find someone within their own organization who has the contact details of the required person at the organization they need to communicate with.

Future State

- ✓ Save time to enable fast communication between trusted organizations that have employees that need to work together regularly. Also highly valuable for single organizations that run multiple Office 365 tenants, such as multi-national corporations.
- Easily access the full capabilities of Teams communication capability, particularly Teams telephony calling to support change management of working habits beyond use of desk phones.
- ✓ Provide administrators with secure control over who can access their organization's address book. A secure connection must be intentionally setup between organizations before search of the address book is possible.

Key Solution Design Considerations


User Experience

- End user Personal Tab are added as part of the app to provide the address search book experience
 - Search look up the required contact in another organization's tenant.
 - Profile End user can manage editable aspects of their profile such as preferred pronoun or OOF.
 - Favourites Quick list of contacts the user regular needs to communicate with.
- Admin user Personal Tab only a global admin as defined by Azure Active
 Directory has the ability to view this tab. It allows setting up the
 authentication 'hand-shake' between two organizations. An API key must be
 provided as a security measure meaning only approved organizations can
 access each other's address book.

Platform Extension Points

- On invoking the personal tab the user can conduct the contact search. Personal tabs can be pinned to the Nav Bar using App Setup policy which would improve the ability to easily access the app.
- The app allows users to communicate across many areas of Teams communications capabilities including:
 - Chat
 - · Teams calling
 - · Telephony calling
 - Schedule a Teams online meeting












Returned search results for contact name.
















Users' can edit allowed fields such as OOF message. Other fields are read-only from Azure Active Directory, such as name and phone.




Sandra Jones, Tenant Administrator
